

- 2. Candidates are required to bring Pencil (# 2 1/2 HB 6000 or # 2-7000) sharpener and eraser in the Examination Hall.
- 3. Candidates must bring their Admit Card / Enrolment Card / College Identity Card to the Examination Hall and must produce the same on demand.
- 4. Resort to unfair means, indiscipline and disturbance is a serious offence, which leads to disqualification for further appearance upto four years.
- 5. Candidates are required to be seated <u>half an hour</u> before starting time of paper in the Examination Hall positively.
- 6. No communication device / digital device / electronic device like Mobile Phone, Video Camera, Bluetooth, MP3, MP4 Player, FM Radio & Audio Recorder etc. is allowed in the Examination Hall, failing which the candidate shall be expelled from the Hall immediately.
- 7. Examination Program may be rescheduled, subject to holiday declared by Government or any unforeseen situation. Students are advised to browse / look at the website on daily basis for updates. It must be noted that some changes (if required) can be made in the prescribed schedule as per contingency.
